Remember to use the full postal address ... how many High Streets are there in Surrey? Or Eastbourne Road's or Park Road's

Giving full information in one sentence saves time and means quicker response (hopefully)

Example ... Caller - "There is a man acting suspiciously in Park Road, Caterham he is near the junction with the High Street, Caterham on the Hill"

**Rather than ... Caller " There is a man acting suspiciously "
Operator " Where is this happening ?"
Caller " Down the Road"
Operator " Which road ?"
Caller " Park Road"
Operator " which Park Road ?"
Caller " The one on the Hill "**

And so on and so on

House names

Whilst on the subject It is a nightmare looking for an address with a housename on the hurry up Imagine in a Police car .. Late October around 8pm its raining the car is steaming up .. Other traffic on the road with bright headlights ... and were looking for a housename sign ... some residents put their house name signs in the most bizarre and hard to find locations .. Or covered by plants or missing altogether ... **PLEASE** have your housename sign in a clear location which is visible from the road, clean and in large print!

Remember the frustration felt on car journeys ... when you are going to a place you have never been before Each junction you come to, the place name is clearly marked on the sign poststhis continues for miles .. Then you come to a large roundabout and no mention of the place you want!
