#### Introduction:

Maggie's Law is a campaign for a change in the laws dealing with attacks on horses and ponies. After an attack in 2007, <u>Davina Bowyer</u> lost her beloved 19 yr old black and white mare in horrific circumstances.

What we would like to see is those who commit attacks like these punished more severely, with sentences being tougher, and more in line with the sentences for those convicted of assault, in the minor cases, and for the major cases, when horses and ponies are put down because of the trauma they have suffered, the sentences should be in line with those for drinking and driving, or causing death by dangerous driving. THE MAXIMUM SENTENCE ANYONE CAN RECEIVE IF CONVICTED OF THESE CRIMES IS SIX MONTHS, we need to change this, as in Maggie's case her attacker received the maximum sentence and was free in 6 weeks!

#### Police recover stolen trailers at New Forest pony sales

Equine Liaison police officers recovered two stolen horse box trailers when they attended the recent Beaulieu Road pony sales in the New Forest.

The officers regularly attend the Sales with Hythe Safer Neighbourhood Officers and other colleagues such as a Force Vehicle examiner to undertake equine crime reduction initiatives. The officers police the Sales by engaging regularly with owners, buyers, sellers and visitors.

They also take the opportunity to look out for stolen property from equine or rural related crimes, whether committed in Hampshire or elsewhere in the UK.

Additionally the officers provide will provide crime reduction advice.

The two trailers they recovered were from crimes committed in Nottingham and Salisbury.

In addition, five visitors to the pony sales received fixed penalty notices of £30 for vehicle related offences, mostly for vehicle registration number plate infringements.

Officers had for the previous three years issued verbal warnings for these offences. As this advice appears to have been ignored, more robust action will now be taken against offenders.

There is a nationwide scam whereby horse owners are answering advertisements for companion horses on loan. The horses are then sold-on by the loaner, without the owner's permission.

The horses shown at <a href="http://www.essexhorsewatch.org.uk/missingonloan.html">http://www.essexhorsewatch.org.uk/missingonloan.html</a> have all been loaned out and are now missing. Some are known to have been sold on. In all cases the true owners did not relinquish ownership and are desperate to trace their animals.

Advertisements wanting to buy or loan horses as companions are being placed on Horse Mart and various editions of the Yellow Advertiser. The names given are different combinations of recurring first name and surnames. In all cases the animals are disposed of quickly through one particular dealer. In loans, the offer of money is a smokescreen to enable the loaner to sell on the horse, by claiming that she bought it from the loaner. In sales, the loaner has the right to sell on, but the manner of obtaining the horse (claiming to want it as a companion and promising to look after it for life) is a criminal deception.


