Horsewatch relaunched in Dorset

We are pleased to announce that Horsewatch is being re-launched in the country of Dorset, with PC 61 Jane Brittain back at the reins. This is great news for all horse owners in Dorset and we hope you will all enthusiastically support Jane in her work. At the moment we are unsure whether the new scheme is for the whole or the part of Dorset in which Jane works, which is the Wimbourne area, but as soon as we know we will share the information with you.

Upgrade your horse's security package!

If you are still unconvinced on the power of freezebranding or microchips please bear in mind the advice we have received from Wetherbys:

"Thank you for keeping us aware of horses which have been stolen in the area. Unfortunately, a photo of the (stolen) horse will not be of any use in preventing the issue of a new or duplicate passport. We would need details that can be matched to those stored on our database, e.g. microchip number or freezebrand."

So this means a stolen horse can be given a new identity simply because their old one cannot be proven. Bearing in mind how many adverts are on the internet for %Bay TB Gelding+or %Riebald Cob Mare+it seems silly not to upgrade from a photographed horse to a microchipped or freezebranded one!

Search High ... And Low!

There have been several incidents where horses have been reported stolen but were subsequently found not very far from their own stables/paddocks. Searches for missing animals have to be VERY thorough in the immediate area because experience is showing that horses, ponies and foals will gain access to areas, which you wouldnot normally consider them entering.

One such story (with a happy ending) is Austin, a dappled grey pony, believed stolen at the same time as his trailer from Cheshire last month. What had actually happened was the trailer thieves had left the gates open and the horses were left to run free. Austin was found four days later up to his belly in muck and water in a cesspit in the garden of a derelict house very close to the field.

Nobody had heard him and as he was below ground level he was not easily spotted. Thankfully, the fire brigade managed to knock down the walls of the pit and get Austin out. He was shaken and cut, with a high temperature, but he is home, alive and on route to making a full recovery.
