Suspicious photographers

Once again, I am receiving info of Asian/eastern European males taking photos of horses in rural areas. PLEASE log this info and report it if you see anything around your stables/fields. Saturday 6th June 2009. 3 Asian males in a dark Taxi on MOOR TOP, GUISELEY taking photos of their horses at 1900 hours.

We have subsequently been told of 2 other occasions where Asian males in a car have followed a young rider, then stopped her and asked if they can take their photograph.

You may recall last year we received a number of reports of eastern European/Asian males in fields and remote areas taking photographs of horses. When approached they became aggressive or said they were working undercover for the police.

This type of incident went quiet for while, however it appears to be picking up again.

It is not clear why these gentlemen are taking photographs of young ladies on horses but in this day and age we can never be too careful about our personal security and surroundings. Although the actions as reported of these males may be innocent the reasons for their behaviour is not clear. It is suggested that on the grounds of commonsense and public protection that if such incidents are witnessed they should be reported to the police and/or local Horsewatch coordinators in order that the incident can be looked into. People are reminded that wherever possible they should record such details as the individuals descriptions, car reg numbers, make and model.

Julie Dennis, of the Community Safety Unit says, %The aim of Horse Watch is to reduce the risk of equestrian related crime by members being aware of the security measures they can take to protect their property. The theft of property is not only devastating financially but can cause immense inconvenience to lose, for example, the saddle that fits your horse like a glove or the trailer you need to transport your horse to shows. As a horse owner I can appreciate the distress that must be experienced if your horse is stolen from its field. I would urge equestrians to look closely at their security and postcode all of their equipment which, in the first instance will make their property undesirable to steal and secondly make it easier to be identified should it be stolen and subsequently recovered.

What like Neighbourhood Watch, much can be achieved through general awareness and a little effort from each individual.+ You dong have to own a horse to become involved; everybody is welcome, whether you just ride occasionally or own the local livery yard. The success of Horse Watch will be in the members and their commitment to sharing important information and helping to reduce the risk of equine crime
