Could we ask all stallion owners be extra vigilant at this time of year as not every mare owner wants to pay stud fees. You may also want to double-check your fences are adequate just in case your stud decides to look for a little more company than you are providing for him.

We would like to welcome the newly formed Wiltshire Horsewatch to the UK Horsewatch Alliance and look forward to hearing from them and any other watches that start up this year.

The long evenings are not deterring criminals . please check out the bulletin for all the suspicious vehicles and people reported this week and please make sure you share information of any sightings you may have. What does deter thieves is noisy alarms and postcoded belongings. Sadly one family home was broken into and both jewellery and a saddle was stolen. Whilst we all like to think our saddles are safe when in our homes and therefore don't need any formal identification this isn't always the case. Could you organise a tack marking session at your yard or club this summer? Perhaps you could make it part of a fun day or yard BBQ?

Roller stolen from a locked field in Swanmore, Hampshire on 9/10 June

A 3 tonne Grays 10ft ballast roller was stolen. The roller was in the field with chain and lock round gate, the lock was cut off and chain taken along with the roller. The roller was half way down the field under the hedge and was lifted onto a vehicle of some kind. Many burglaries can be prevented. Keep doors and windows locked at all times. Remove all keys from the locks and keep them in a safe place and out of view. Avoid leaving property like handbags, keys, or laptops in hallways, or where they can be seen from outside the house. Keep garden furniture, ladders, and wheelie bins in a secure garage or shed, or locked up away from the house, where they might be used to climb onto a roof or access a first floor window. Be a good neighbour - be aware of sounds like breaking glass. Report any suspicious activity or vehicles, in the area.

Horse injured

Horsewatch Message 17/9/2009

I wanted to let you know about an incident which has been reported to the Police in the last few days. The incident occurred near to Bretforton.

A pony had been tied up in a yard by the owner who had bathed her and got her ready to go off to an event. She was booted and bandaged and left in situ for approximately 5 minutes while the owner went indoors to collect something. When the owner returned it was evident that she had received a clean vertical cut to the area underneath her tail. The injury required veterinary treatment and several stitches internally and externally.

At this time we cannot substantiate how the injury occurred but it appears unlikely that it was accidental. The area where she was standing has been checked but there is nothing nearby which could have caused the injury.

Please bear in mind that there were two incidents of a similar nature which took place last year. One was at Bowers Hill, Badsey, and the other one was near to Drakes Broughton. I would ask you all to be vigilant and to report any incident which you feel may be suspicious. If anyone has any further information regarding this type of incident please let me know.
