Summary of Reported Rural Crime

Most disturbingly, there have been a number of burglaries to rural dwellings over the last week. These are concentrated in the East Hampshire area, but there have also been two reported offences in the rural Basingstoke area. Mostly, jewellery and cash has been taken during these offences.

We have also seen a rise in burglaries to non dwelling premises, such as sheds, garages and out buildings. The items stolen at the majority of these incidents have been gardening type power tools. At one incident two quad bikes were stolen and at four locations nothing at all was taken. These offences have taken place mainly in the Rural Andover, Hart and Rushmoor area.

Theft of heating oil has dropped with only one reported incident North Hampshire this month.

Another twin axle trailer has been stolen from the Medstead area, and a decorative traditional Gypsy caravan has been stolen from a farm in the Headley area.
