Generally, it appears to be a quiet period for reported equine related crime or incidents, which is a good thing. The regular contributors appear to have little to report on and this includes Hampshire. Again, there are those counties that never supply information so we are none the wiser about what happens in those areas.

It may be that crime is being committed but not reported thereby giving a false indicator that crime is down and on the decrease. Always report crime to your police. What they do with the information is their decision. However if you feel inclined ask them what enquiries and investigation they have actually done!!

Remember never be complacent because the next victim of a crime could be YOU!!

Please read if you use or store fertiliser

This message has been passed on via the Hampshire Constabulary Country Watch Team. The sentiments apply nationally.

In the last week, two reports have been received involving theft of fertiliser. Whilst these have not occurred in Hampshire, and their intended use is not known, it provides an opportunity to raise awareness once again about the use and storage of fertiliser. Terrorist groups around the world have for many years misused fertilisers to make explosive devices. The majority of these devices have contained ammonium nitrate based products, combined with other materials to produce explosives. Other fertilisers such as urea, potassium nitrate and sodium nitrate have also been misused. Even in relatively small quantities, ammonium fertiliser-based explosives can cause a great deal of destruction. Many of the most notorious terrorist attacks of the last 15 years - from Oklahoma City to Omagh - were carried out using fertiliser-based explosive devices.

The UK has a history of terrorist attacks using fertiliser based explosives dating back to the early 1970s. The Northern Ireland 'troubles' saw both Republican and Loyalist terrorist groups deploying explosive devices containing fertiliser which resulted in significant fatalities, injuries and damage. More recently, dissident Republican groups such as the 'Real' IRA (RIRA) and the Continuity IRA (CIRA) have rejected the Good Friday agreement and still pose a serious threat to the UK mainland and Northern Ireland. International terrorists also pose a significant threat to the UK and UK interests abroad. The events of 7 July 2005 in London demonstrate both the capability and intent of groups in launching attacks that are either inspired or coordinated by radical, extremist groups based overseas such as Al Qaida.

Key attacks in the UK using fertiliser based explosives include South Quay - London Docklands (1996), Manchester (1996), Omagh, Co. Tyrone (1998), BBC TV Centre, London (2001), Ealing Broadway, London (2001), Birmingham (failed to fully detonate - 2001).

Groups such as FARC (Columbia), ETA (Spain), Hezbollah (Israel and Occupied Territories), Tamil Tigers (Sri Lanka) and Al Qaida (international) have all used fertiliser based explosives, again with devastating results. Notable attacks have included World Trade Centre, New York (1993), Buenos Aires, Argentina (1994), Oklahoma City, US (1995), Bali, Indonesia (2002), British Consulate Istanbul (2003), Mumbai, India (2006) and Oslo, Norway (2011).

It should be noted that all of these attacks combined (both UK and overseas), which killed over 700 people and caused billions of pounds worth of damage, used a total of

less than 12 tonnes of fertiliser. This is only about half a lorry load of fertiliser.

Please make every effort to store fertiliser away from public access, never leave it in a field overnight and always store it out of view from public areas. Wherever possible store it inside a locked building, carry out frequent stock checks and report any unexplained stock discrepancy/loss/theft to the police **IMMEDIATELY**.
