#### **Suspicious Incidents**

Although the below message comes from Gwent Police and is directed towards people in that area, the message can be applicable to any part of the country. Remember thieves travel to any part of the country. They don't commit crime just in their own area! Whether it is railway property or property elsewhere if you are suspicious about individuals or vehicles phone the police via 101 to let them know. If you believe or know a crime is being committed dial 999. Before you phone try to get your location right. This will allow the police to be directed to the right place.

#### **Suspicious Vehicles Around Railway Lines**

A member of British Transport Police has asked for help in relation to ANY suspicious vehicles seen around or near to any railway lines throughout Gwent, in particular around the Marshfield area and immediate areas around it.

# Warning of Scam

The below information comes from Lincolnshire Police. Please read and take note of the scam.

PC Snell from Lincolnshire Police is currently investigating a number of offences of fraud whereby an individual, in this case a female, has approached members on online sites who are asking for saddles for sale. This individual offers a variety of saddles for very cheap prices using stolen photographs, and insists that buyers transfer money directly into her account, refusing to use PayPal. She will send false parcel tracking numbers – some genuine but not referring to the appropriate parcel – as proof of delivery so that buyer feels comfortable in sending the payment. The parcel then never arrives and contact is cut between the offender and the victim.

At present there are six known victims from all over the country and from various websites. The offender is still actively trying to commit these offences, until she is apprehended she may continue to do so.

Users should be aware that they should only ever pay for online goods using secure means such as PayPal. Fraudsters can be extremely convincing and give numerous stories as to why they should be trusted, even falsely stating they are police officers and attaching photographs.

Users are reminded of internet safety and never send money to someone that they do not know, regardless of how much "proof" they receive that it is legitimate business and person they are dealing with.

## **Horse Passports**

#### Information kindly submitted by Sussex Horsewatch.

Did you know that it is illegal to buy or sell an equine without a valid passport. Information has been taken from both the BHS web site and that of DEFRA - enjoy the reading.

The BHS Passport Office issues passports to horses, ponies, donkeys and mules of unknown breeding and those that are not eligible to be registered with a breed society.

For the purpose of the information contained on our website 'horse' refers throughout to horses, ponies, donkeys and mules.

The BHS are only able to make changes to passports originally issued by the Society. Please ensure you contact the correct Passport Issuing Organisation (PIO) as all non-BHS passports or application forms received will be immediately returned to the sender. Details of authorised PIOs are available from Defra.

You do not have to be a member of the BHS to obtain a passport or complete any updates on a BHS passport.

Please see the links on the left hand side for more information about the services available for BHS passports. A list of frequently asked questions is available for specific issues regarding passports. If you need any additional information, please contact the Passport Office on 02476 840574 or email passports@bhs.org.uk.

Each specific service details the time it will take for the BHS Passport Office to complete the process. Please note we do not currently offer a fast track service so please allow the specific time for the service to be completed. The BHS cannot be held responsible for any passports that are lost or damaged in the post.

The BHS has issued over 35,000 passports. Over this time the front cover of the passport has been amended three times. All BHS passports remain valid regardless of the logo your horse's passport has. To help identify a BHS passport, the three cover versions are below:



The most up-to-date version is the red covered passport, which is bound together using two rivets.

All pages contained within the passport have 'Equine Passport' written in the background diagonally across the pages. Any pages which do not carry this watermark were not issued by the BHS and suggest that the passport has been tampered with. This should be reported to Trading Standards.

On the first page is an embossed mark which is completed on the date the passport was issued. If this mark is missing it suggests that the passport has been tampered with. This should be reported to Trading Standards.

## 1. Overview

All horses, ponies, donkeys and related animals (including zoo species like zebras) must have a horse passport.

The passport is a small booklet that identifies your animal by its height and species.

It also states whether your animal can be used for food at the end of its life. You can declare that your animal isn't intended for human consumption yourself by filling in the appropriate section of the passport. This can't be changed later.

If you don't make the declaration in the passport, it's assumed the animal is intended for human consumption at the end of its life.

All horse passports issued since 1 July 2009 must contain a microchip number.

A passport is needed for each animal and lasts the animal's lifetime.

It must be with the animal at all times, eg if you keep your animal in a livery stable the passport must be kept at the stable.

You need to show it:

- on demand from a local authority enforcement officer, like a Trading Standards inspector
- when you sell or give the animal to someone else
- when a vet examines or treats your animal

You could get a fine of up to £5000 if you can't show a valid horse passport for an animal in your care. Contact your local Trading Standards office if you suspect someone is keeping an animal without a passport.

## 2. Apply for a horse passport

You must be the owner of the animal to apply for a horse passport in England. There are different horse identification rules in Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. You'll need to ask a vet to microchip your animal and fill out its identification details on the passport application form at the same time. Your animal will have to be signed out of the human food chain if it's is micro-chipped before you apply for a passport.

## When to apply

You must get the foal micro-chipped and have a passport before it's 6 months old, or by 31 December in the year it's born (whichever is later). It's an offence if you don't apply by this deadline. You also won't be able to sell your animal for human food at the end of its working life.

## How to apply

Apply through any Passport Issuing Organisation (PIO). You can apply online with some PIOs otherwise use the application form they give you. You need to register pedigree animals with a Passport Issuing Organisation (PIO) that manages studbooks.

Contact a PIO if you need help filling out your application.

## What to include

Your vet must fill out the microchip and identification details and sign and stamp your application form. You may also need a diagram of the animal ('silhouette'). The PIO will let you know if this is needed.

## How much it costs

The cost varies between PIOs. Fees may be higher for pedigree animals.

#### When you'll be sent your passport

You'll usually receive your horse passport within 4 weeks.

## 3. Use your horse passport

You need to show your passport on demand from a local authority enforcement officer. You'll also need it at certain points in your animal's life.

#### When you sell or buy an animal

Give the passport to the new owner if you sell your animal. You could be prosecuted if you don't. Make sure you get the passport of any horse or related animal that you buy. Tell the PIO that issued the passport that you're the new owner within 30 days. Contact your local Trading Standards office if someone tries to sell you a horse or related animal without a passport.

#### When your animal needs medical attention

You need to give your horse passport to a vet before they treat your animal. This tells the vet which category your animal is in and determines which medications it can receive. The vet will sign an animal out of the food chain in Section IX before giving it medication that makes it unfit for human consumption. Ask a vet if you're not sure whether you need to sign your animal out of the food chain for over-the-counter medications, eg wormers.

#### When the animal dies

When the animal dies, send the passport to the PIO that issued it to have it invalidated. It's an offence if you don't do this within 30 days.

#### 4. Replace a lost horse passport

If you've lost your horse passport you'll need to apply for a new one from the PIO that issued it. If you don't know which office that was, talk to any PIO.

You won't be able to sell your animal for human food at the end of its working life if it's ever had a replacement passport.

#### 5. Import or export a horse or related animal

The rules for importing horses or related animals are different depending on where the animal's coming from.

## Import a horse or related animal from within the EU

Any horse or related animal you import from an EU country must have:

- a valid passport issued by a Passport Issuing Organisation (PIO) in the EU
- the relevant health checks

# *If your animal doesn't have a passport, you must apply for one within 30 days of it clearing customs. You could be fined up to £5000 if you don't do this.*

#### Import a horse or related animal from outside the EU

Contact the Animal Health and Veterinary Laboratories Agency if you're importing or exporting a horse or related animal from outside the EU.

#### 6. Contact the helpline

Contact the Passport Issuing Organisation (PIO) specific to your breed if you have any questions about horse passports.

If you have any concerns about the conduct of PIOs, contact the Department for Environment Food and Rural Affairs (Defra).

# At the time of circulating this bulletin these horses are still to be considered as stolen; the circulating Police Force have confirmed that there has not been any development.

#### West Mercia Police – Horse Theft Alert

A horse is believed to be stolen from a field in Shiffnal. This happened on Saturday 5th September between 12.30 - 2pm. PC John Phelan is investigating the burglary and said:

"Cecil is very small and would be very distressed to be away from his mother and the safe environment the stable offers. Likewise, Cecil's owner is absolutely distraught with worry. Cecil is a very distinctive pony and I would urge anyone who believes they know of his location to contact me immediately. Anyone who remembers seeing anything unusual or suspicious between yesterday evening and this morning in the area of Summerhouse Lane should also contact me as they may have information that can assist our investigation."
