Important changes in Trespass of Animal Act 1971

Information from Suffolk

The below information is slightly historical and the scheme will be in place.

The new 'Police Support Volunteers on Horseback' scheme will be launched at the Suffolk show next week. These volunteers will be a new addition to the bank of PSV's already embedded across Suffolk Constabulary. PSV's undertake vetting and force induction training and are a highly valued edition to the policing family, they do not wear uniform but in some roles volunteers are provided with protective clothing such as high visibility jackets. PSV's help support Suffolk Police in a number of ways and our goal is for volunteers to be involved in as many aspects of our service as possible. One such area is Rural Crime and 'Volunteers on Horseback' will assist Suffolk Police by being a highly visible and accessible point of contact on horseback for rural community safety issues and to report any suspicious activity or damage directly to Suffolk Police, whilst offering a reassuring presence to the local community. This is a 'see and report' scheme only,

PCC Tim Passmore said, "I am delighted to support this innovative project which will provide additional highly visible patrols to support our rural policing teams. Our mounted police volunteers will provide an invaluable 'see and report' resource, reporting any suspicious activity or criminal damage directly to the Constabulary. He added "Our volunteers will provide extra eyes and ears to the Constabulary, they will not get involved in operational policing."

Karen Harris, PSV co-ordinator will be at the Suffolk Show promoting the scheme in the Public Services stand which will be located on the Flower Show Avenue in stand 668 – look out for the police tractor.

Karen will be able to give more information on the 'Police Support Volunteers on Horseback' scheme along with other volunteering opportunities with Suffolk Police.

Suffolk Police urges competitors at horse shows to use common sense and ensure they are not easy targets.

It is easy to assume that you're with like-minded people and drop your guard, but that's when you're vulnerable and thieves take advantage.

Don't leave your saddle resting against the horse box or the bridle hanging off the wing mirror – when unattended lock your tack away. Don't leave your handbag, mobile phone or wallet lying on the front seat of an unlocked vehicle. Remain vigilant and if you see anyone lurking around the lorry park that seems suspicious or out of place, immediately contact the police or a show steward.

They work closely with the British Horse Society in highlighting the dangers of loose dogs around horses. Whether a dog attacks a horse or just wants to play the consequences can have the same result, serious injuries to the rider, horse or dog. Stolen Horses

At the time of circulating this bulletin these horses are still to be considered as stolen; the circulating Police Force have confirmed that there has not been any development.

West Mercia Police – Horse Theft Alert

A horse is believed to be stolen from a field in Shiffnal. This happened on Saturday 5th September between 12.30 - 2pm. It is believed that offenders have walked across a cornfield to reach a 17 acre sized field that is rented by the owner. They have then removed posts supporting the fence and have walked the horse across the corn field to a waiting vehicle, possibly a 4x4 with a trailer.

The horse is an 18 month old Cob, 13.2 hands, black and white with a grey patch on the side of its neck with four white socks. Its face is Black and White with a flash down the centre of its face. At the top of the flash there is a black spot.

A few weeks before the owner noticed that the mane had been plaited on the horse. If you have any information that can help police with their enquiries please call 101 quoting **reference number 557s050914**.

Cecil is a very distinctive pony and I would urge anyone who believes they know of his location to contact me immediately. Anyone who remembers seeing anything unusual or suspicious between yesterday evening and this morning in the area of Summerhouse Lane should also contact me as they may have information that can assist our investigation.”

Since the last bulletin there have been several equine related crimes in Hampshire. These range from theft of electric fencing from fields to theft of small amounts of tack

A significant amount of tack was stolen overnight of 29th – 30th May 2015 from a stable in Yateley. Saddles, head collars, blankets, lead ropes were stolen. Also stolen was a wheel barrow. Once again horse owners are reminded to lock away or chain up wheel barrows when not in use. Thieves use wheel barrows to help them transport away stolen goods!

On 29th May 2015 5 shetland ponies (stallions) were abandoned on private land in Petersfield area. The Control of Horses Act 2015 which came into force on the 26th May 2015 were brought into play. The ponies were retained for the statutory 4 days. No owner came forward and the ponies which were in poor condition were removed in accordance with the regulation.

In May there was a report of two mares being stolen from their field in the Fordingbridge area. It was apparent that the horses had been removed. An extensive search was made by the owners. Fortunately the horses were found. They were found 20 miles from their field. Horse theft is still very rare anywhere in the country but horse owners must not be complacent and ensure that their horses are as protected as they can be.
