A horse is believed to be stolen from a field in Shiffnal. This happened on Saturday 5th September between 12.30 - 2pm. It is believed that offenders have walked across a cornfield to reach a 17 acre sized field that is rented by the owner. They have then removed posts supporting the fence and have walked the horse across the corn field to a waiting vehicle, possibly a 4x4 with a trailer.

The horse is an 18 month old Cob, 13.2 hands, black and white with a grey patch on the side of its neck with four white socks. Its face is Black and White with a flash down the centre of its face. At the top of the flash there is a black spot.

Cecil is a very distinctive pony and I would urge anyone who believes they know of his location to contact me immediately. Anyone who remembers seeing anything unusual or suspicious between yesterday evening and this morning in the area of Summerhouse Lane should also contact me as they may have information that can assist our investigation.”
