Important Message from North Yorkshire Police

[Press Release Scarborough/Ryedale]

Police are urgently appealing for assistance in locating a convicted murderer who is wanted for emergency recall to prison, after he breached his release licence. William Kerr, 53, needs to be arrested and returned to prison as a matter of urgency. If seen, people are asked not to approach him but instead to call the police immediately on 999.

Kerr was jailed for life for murder at Leeds Crown Court on 26 June 1998, and released on licence on 23 January 2015. The National Offender Management Service contacted North Yorkshire Police for assistance after Kerr absconded from approved premises in Hull. His current whereabouts are not known, however he is known to have links to the Humberside, West Yorkshire and London areas. Officers are currently conducting extensive enquiries to locate him as a matter of urgency.

Two photographs of Kerr have been circulated to the press and published on social media.

Detective Inspector Eamonn Clarke, of North Yorkshire Police, said: “To assist our already extensive efforts to trace William Kerr, I am urging people to keep an eye out for the man in the photographs. We ask that you do not approach Kerr, as he is considered dangerous. You should contact the police straight away on 999 and officers will be despatched to arrest him or investigate the sighting.”

DI Clarke is also appealing directly to Kerr: “William, you know you have breached your licence conditions, and by continuing to do so you are only making things worse. It is now time to do the right thing and hand yourself in to the police.”

If you have seen William Kerr or have information about his current whereabouts, please dial 999 and pass details to North Yorkshire Police stating the “William Kerr appeal”.

If you would prefer to remain anonymous, please contact Crimestoppers on 0800 555 111, quoting North Yorkshire Police reference number 12150049525 and say it is “urgent”.

There is no evidence at this time to suggest that he is currently in North Yorkshire.

Stolen Horses

West Mercia Police – Horse Theft Alert

A horse is believed to be stolen from a field in Shiffnal. This happened on Saturday 5th September between 12.30 - 2pm. It is believed that offenders have walked across a cornfield to reach a 17 acre sized field that is rented by the owner. They have then removed posts supporting the fence and have walked the horse across the corn field to a waiting vehicle, possibly a 4x4 with a trailer.

The horse is an 18 month old Cob, 13.2 hands, black and white with a grey patch on the side of its neck with four white socks. Its face is Black and White with a flash down the centre of its face. At the top of the flash there is a black spot.

Have you seen Cecil the Shetland pony? - Aldenham

Police are releasing images of a month old pony that was stolen in Aldenham in an attempt to locate him and identify those who have taken him. The Shetland pony called Cecil was stolen from a stable at a property in Summerhouse Lane sometime between 7pm yesterday (Thursday, August 14) and 7am today (Friday, August 15). PC John Phelan is investigating the burglary and said:

“Cecil is very small and would be very distressed to be away from his mother and the safe environment the stable offers. Likewise, Cecil’s owner is absolutely distraught with worry. Cecil is a very distinctive pony and I would urge anyone who believes they know of his location to contact me immediately. Anyone who remembers seeing anything unusual or suspicious between yesterday evening and this morning in the area of Summerhouse Lane should also contact me as they may have information that can assist our investigation.”

Shotguns Stolen - Chinnor

Thames Valley Police is appealing for information after a series of burglaries in Chinnor that officers believe are linked. Several high value items and shotguns were taken during the incidents. Between 7.45am and 3.45pm on Friday (6/3) offenders gained entry to a property on Timber Way, Chinnor by smashing a glass panel on the rear kitchen door panel and using the keys that were in the lock to open the door. The offenders forced a gun cabinet from the wall of the master bedroom and stole the four shotguns that were kept inside it.

The victim inherited the shotguns, which previously belonged to the deceased father of the victim. The details are as follows:

- A rare Miroku Presidential over/under, 12 bore shot gun, which has an oval silver crest pressed into the wooden butt of the gun. This has been rounded and polished.
- A Miroku over/under 12 bore shot gun.
- A Miroku over/under, 12 bore, self-loading shot gun
- A Miroku over/under, 12 bore shot gun
- A .22 air rifle
- A blue handbag containing shooting vests, ear defenders and shot gun certificates.
- Several high-value pieces of jewellery inherited by the victim were also stolen in the incident. An Omega Constellation wrist watch, a pocket watch, and a Rolex GMT Master Wrist watch were taken in the incident.

Officers believe the three incidents from the weekend are connected to recent burglaries in Tilehurst and Reading, and also another burglary in Hampshire

On Monday 9th March at 9.15pm at a farm in Wargrave, a green Landrover Defender was stolen index RN ** LXJ. The owner saw it being driven away followed by another car. The police confirm that the car had been involved in a burglary in Newbury. It later drove through Egham at 10.30 p.m.

Between 7th and 9th March, at a farm in Brize Norton, offenders entered the rear of a solar farm under construction from a bridle path across a field. They then cut copper cables from the solar panels and stole at least two separate drums of cabling.

Dogwatch Alert No.1057

On Tuesday 10th March, overnight, at a farm in Shurlock Row, offenders drove a vehicle onto the farm grounds, forcing open the electric entrance gates, damaging the mechanism. They then drove into the farm compound, where there are industrial units rented by separate businesses. The offenders drove around for several minutes before leaving the same way they arrived. Nothing appears to have been stolen. CCTV shows a vehicle (a two door Mitsubishi Shogun in blue/green with a silver/grey bumper and a rear spare wheel) but does not reveal an index.

On Tuesday 10th March, overnight between 4.10 AM and 5 AM at a farm in Sulhampstead, offenders entered farm land from Harts Lane, using one or more vehicles. They removed small trees and a public footpath sign to access the property. The doors to a barn were then forced open and several motorcycles, lawnmowers and power tools were stolen. Tyre tracks then lead back towards Harts Lane again.
