Scams Reminder - Oct 2012

Beware of the numerous scams circulating either via phone or email often from Asia or Africa and within the UK. The content of the conversation is usually very plausible with some details sounding correct and personal to the recipient but often a further request for personal banking details are required and a fee. The caller often states an order has been placed eg; for unwanted phone calls or for advertising. As always please be advised NOT to pass any bank details over the phone or computer

Community Message from Dorset Police - 24th October 2012

It is an offence to place anything on the road that may cause harm to another road user. **This includes mud.** Civil claims against farmers have run into millions which may not be recoverable from insurance, if reasonable efforts have not been made clear. Road sweepers can be hired and should be used where necessary.

Police receive numerous complaints during maize harvest and try to deal as leniently as possible, but the responsibility remains with the person making the mess. Police can arrange for the road to be swept at the farmer's expense if action is not taken when required. Busy roads cannot just be left uncleared until the end of the working day. They must be safely passable to all road users all the time.

Remember, a civil claim against you, in certain circumstances, could result in the loss of your farm. The cost of a sweeper could appear small, set against the cost of a civil claim.

Officers from the North of Hampshire including PC Jon Radcliffe assisted in hosting the Annual National Wildlife Crime Conference at Bramshill last weekend. It was attended by approx 120 delegates from across the Country. This gave an opportunity for the Hampshire Country Watch Officers to pass on Good Practice to other Police Forces and partner agencies involved in wild life crime.

Barn Fire - Walkern

Police are investigating an attempted burglary and a subsequent fire at a stable yard in Bennington Road in Walkern, in which four horses have sadly died. ***** Barn Fire Update *****

Police in East Herts have arrested a 43-year-old local man in connection with an attempted burglary and a subsequent fire at a stable yard in Benington Road in Walkern, in which four horses died, on October 3rd. The incident has caused great concern to many people, especially horse-owners, so we feel it is important to let residents in neighbouring rural areas know about the action police have been able to take. The man was arrested at an address in Walkern just before 8am this morning (Tuesday October 16). Chief Inspector for East Herts Gerry McDonald said: *"We take these kinds of offences very seriously and are completely committed to tackling rural crime. This kind of crime has a huge impact on the local community and I hope today's arrest will reassure local residents that we will deal robustly with these types of offences when they occur."*
