Stolen Horses

At the time of circulating this bulletin these horses are still to be considered as stolen; the circulating Police Force have confirmed that there has not been any development.

West Mercia Police – Horse Theft Alert

A horse is believed to have been stolen from a field in Shiffnal. This happened on Saturday 5th September between 12.30 - 2pm. It is believed offenders have walked across a cornfield to reach a 17 acre sized field that is rented by the owner. They have then removed posts supporting the fence and have walked the horse across the cornfield to a waiting vehicle, possibly a 4x4 with a trailer.

The horse is an 18 month old Cob, 13.2 hands, black and white with a grey patch on the side of its neck with four white socks. Its face is Black and White with a flash down the centre of its face. At the top of the flash there is a black spot.

A few weeks before the owner noticed that the mane had been plaited on the horse. If you have any information that can help police with their enquiries please call 101 quoting **reference number 557s050914**.

Police are releasing images of a month old pony that was stolen in Aldenham in an attempt to locate him and identify those who have taken him. The Shetland pony called Cecil was stolen from a stable at a property in Summerhouse Lane sometime between 7pm yesterday (Thursday, August 14) and 7am today (Friday, August 15). PC John Phelan is investigating the burglary and said:

“Cecil is very small and would be very distressed to be away from his mother and the safe environment the stable offers. Likewise, Cecil’s owner is absolutely distraught with worry. Cecil is a very distinctive pony and I would urge anyone who believes they know of his location to contact me immediately. Anyone who remembers seeing anything unusual or suspicious between yesterday evening and this morning in the area of Summerhouse Lane should also contact me as they may have information that can assist our investigation.”

When? Overnight 7th - 8th December 2014

Equine premises at Holt Pound on the Hampshire/Surrey border was broken into and a substantial amount of tack and associated equine property was stolen. About £25,000 worth of property was stolen.

I am told that there has been an equine burglary in Elstead, Surrey and a yard in Grayshot, Hampshire was "visited" but nothing taken.

Advice

- The important thing is to warn all horse owners that the above crime has been committed and as I repeatedly say all areas of this county are vulnerable to crime. It matters not if you are a big equine concern or a single horse owner your property is just as likely to be stolen.
- Review your stable/property security now not after the crime has been committed.
- Remember thieves that steal equine property are not speculative. They will plan their crime which invariably means they visit places they intend to steal from. Get used to being observant and report all vehicles and persons you see in your locality who you do not recognise to the police. **NON EMERGENCY CALLS TO THE POLICE DIAL 101.**

- When you phone the police always get a reference number.
- Thieves travel. The persons responsible may not be local to the area and will in all probability be part of an organised crime group who travel to commit crime

EIGHT ARRESTED ON SUSPICION OF HUNTING ACT OFFENCES IN THE THAMES VALLEY

Eight men were arrested on Thursday 4th December on suspicion of hunting act and animal cruelty offences. Seven of the eight men were from outside of Thames Valley and live in Gloucestershire, Hampshire, Sussex and Surrey. The arrests were part of an organised campaign to target rural crime in the South and Vale local police area, as part of Operation Monocle. During searches carried out by police, five dogs were seized as well as other items related to the alleged offences.

The Police and Crime Commissioner for Thames Valley, Anthony Stansfeld, said:

“Thames Valley Police have become increasingly effective at catching those who travel into the Thames Valley to commit crimes of this nature and I hope these arrests will serve as a warning to any others considering doing this in the future.”

Andy Boyd, Superintendent of South Oxfordshire and the Vale of the White Horse Local Police Area said:
“These arrests enforce our message that people who travel from outside the region to Thames Valley to commit crime will face the consequences.

“Between 1 August 2013 and 24 November 2013, we had 42 Hunting Act offences across our area. Since 1 August 2014 we have had 32 offences but have arrested 41 people, 31 of which are on police bail while enquiries continue.

“Considering we arrested 29 people during the whole of 2013 for hunting/poaching offences, we’re pleased to see our proactive approach to rural crime is paying off, reflected in our arrest rates.”
