Information & Advice

Dear Reader, the below information has been forwarded by Sussex Horsewatch. The information is relevant to any area. Your particular police force may or may not carry out a similar campaign to enforce road traffic law. You may drive from one county into another where one police force enforces differently to another. All those readers who travel into Sussex are warned.

Also remember that the trailer being towed must display the same registration number as the towing vehicle. The majority of towed trailers do not and that is illegal. That observation may cause you to be stopped and from that moment other offences are disclosed.

It may cost you to be legal in every sense but it will cost you more if you are not legal!!

Equally watch you speed when towing a trailer. There is a maximum speed limit which is 60 mph but you should drive at a speed that is safe and appropriate. Towing a laden trailer at 60 mph is not safe and appropriate.

Sussex Police have asked me to remind members about the rules concerning towing horse boxes. This is because they have noticed many vehicles pulling trailers are not legal and rather than just stopping and prosecuting you they wanted to give you a last chance.

Firstly you must have an appropriate Driving Licence (see below) then there is the question of, is the vehicle you tow with legally allowed to tow a trailer, if it is not (and many are not) when using it to tow, you are not insured. Not only that your vehicle will be impounded and you will automatically get 6 points on your licence, plus a £200/£300 fine. So please check the regulations.

Just because you are pulling an empty trailer does not exempt you from the regulations, the law always looks at the maximum gross weight. If you are not sure if you look at the registration document of your vehicle it states on it the maximum gross towing weights, then look at the plate on your trailer (usually on the draw bar) that gives you the gross maximum weights.

Scam Alert

The below advice from Hampshire could be replicated in any part of the country so please be aware

Please be aware of incidences of telephone calls to residents in Waterlooville and surrounding areas which falsely claim to be from police. In some cases names of officers, ranks and police station addresses have been used to make the call seem more genuine.

The callers will say there is a problem with the person's credit card and financial issues and then request banking and other personal details to aid security.

This is a criminal scam being investigated by us. Remember, **no-one will ever need this information from you** - not the police, the banks or any other callers. Never give out your banking and personal details to anyone and should you receive such a call then you should end the call immediately and ring the police on 101.

West Mercia Police – Horse Theft Alert

A horse is believed to be stolen from a field in Shiffnal. This happened on Saturday 5th September between 12.30 - 2pm. It is believed that offenders have walked across a corn field to reach a 17 acre sized field that is rented by the owner. They have then removed posts supporting the fence and have walked the horse across the corn field to a waiting vehicle, possibly a 4x4 with a trailer.

The horse is an 18 month old Cob, 13.2 hands, black and white with a grey patch on the side of its neck with four white socks. Its face is Black and White with a flash down the centre of its face. At the top of the flash there is a black spot.

A few weeks before the owner noticed that the mane had been plaited on the horse. If you have any information that can help police with their enquiries please call 101 quoting **reference number 557s050914**.

At the time of circulating this bulletin these horses are still to be considered as stolen; the circulating Police Force have confirmed that there has not been any development.

Have you seen Cecil the Shetland pony? - Aldenham

Police are releasing images of a one month old pony that was stolen in Aldenham in an attempt to locate him and identify those who have taken him. The Shetland pony called Cecil was stolen from a stable at a property in Summerhouse Lane sometime between 7pm yesterday (Thursday, August 14) and 7am today (Friday, August 15). PC John Phelan is investigating the burglary and said:

“Cecil is very small and would be very distressed to be away from his mother and the safe environment the stable offers. Likewise, Cecil’s owner is absolutely distraught with worry. Cecil is a very distinctive pony and I would urge anyone who believes they know of his location to contact me immediately. Anyone who remembers seeing anything unusual or suspicious between yesterday evening and this morning in the area of Summerhouse Lane should also contact me as they may have information that can assist our investigation.”

More Dogs Stolen!

Hare Coursing

It is safe to assume that the sudden increase in the theft of 'long dogs' (Salukis and Greyhounds) is directly related to the fact that it is the time of year when hare coursing is on the increase. Please report any sightings of hare coursing taking place to the police IMMEDIATELY. The people conducting this activity may well be involved in other crimes including dog theft so please report them. Ideally, get car registration numbers, descriptions of occupants etc. If you don't want to report the information to the police then please pass the information on to me and I will get it passed on. Time is of the essence when trying to catch these people so please act as quickly as you can. Thank you.

Trailer Stolen

Once in the field the offenders have taken down the electric fence and used the earth stake to force the lock off of the horse trailer. The trailer was not visible from the road.
